Our Work During the Mumbai

Marathon

With the help of more than 60 Volunteers from Fr. Conceicao Rodrigues College Of Engineering (Bandra), we collected more than **10 Thousand food packets** after the Marathon and redistributed it in **2020**. Similarly, in **2019** we had collected and distributed **19,000 food packets** after the Mumbai Marathon

We collected the surplus Bananas, Cakes, Khakras (Snack) and buttermilk that was left after the TATA Mumbai Marathon and distributed it to the children and the elderly resident of slums.







The Work We Do and Our Growth



Within a span of 2 years, Mumbai Roti Bank has organized 10 lakh+ meals

The hunger crisis is pretty simple: On one hand there's a surplus, while on the other, extreme deficiency.

Bridging the two together in the past year, we have attempted to fight hunger and bring the excess food from privileged pockets to the underprivileged ones, serving around 1 million meals in the process.
